# Snowdropsy the COW1

A warm lace cowl knit in the round from the bottom-up, designed for my little one on her northern winter adventure. The cowl takes its name from the snowdrop lace pattern.



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#### SIZE

To fit a child / adult

Finished neck circ: 34cm / 40cm

Finished base circ: 56cm / 62cm

Finished length: 19cm / 22cm

#### YARN

 $1 \times 50g$  Rare Essentials (alpaca, mohair and superfine merino) Misty Rasberry, 100m approx..

#### NEEDLES

40cm x 6mm circular needles

#### GAUGE

14 sts and 20 rows to 10cm in St st using 6mm needles

#### SPECIAL STITCHES

SNOWDROP LACE STITCH

Knit SSK

/ K2tog

Every alternate row is knitted. However there is no knit round between the last round of the pattern and the first round of the next pattern repeat.

#### Lower Rib Band

CO 56 (64) sts.

Join for working in the round being careful not to twist the stitches. Mark beginning of round.

Round 1: \* K1, P1; repeat from \* to end of round.

Repeat round 1 until piece measures 3.5cm from beg.

## Lace Body

Work chart 7 (8) times around, placing markers between each repeat for ease of counting.

Work chart through 3 (4) times.

Next round: K removing all markers except for beginning of round.

# Neck Edge Rib Band

Decrease round: Beginning with K2tog, continue in pattern Pl, Kl, decreasing l every 10<sup>th</sup> st till the end of the round. 50sts (58sts)

Next round: \*Kl, Pl; repeat from \* to end of round.

Repeat this round until rib band measures 5.5cm from beginning of rib.

BO loosely in pattern.

## Finishing

Wet block to finished measurements.
